

Electric Vehicle In-Home Charging Program

Save Money Every Time You Plug in Your Car!

Charge your Electric Vehicle (EV) in the convenience of your home! Blue Earth Light and Water (BELW) now offers an EV charging program that features an affordable time-of-use rate. To save even more money, residential customers can also take advantage of a **\$500 rebate** towards the purchase and installation of a EV charger.

This program is available to electric BELW customers who own an electrically powered vehicle used for on road transportation. Charging of the vehicle can occur at any time but will be subject to "on-peak" and "off-peak" energy charges per hour daily. Off peak hours will occur between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Customer Program Requirements:

- Customer will purchase 120 or 240 volt electric vehicle charging station that is used for the sole purpose of charging on road vehicles.
- Customer is responsible for the purchase and installation of a separate meter socket with a bypass and disconnecting means in a mutually agreed upon location with BELW. (NEC article 230.85)
- Inspection by State Certified electrical inspector of all metering equipment is required before the meter will be installed by BELW.
- The customer will be responsible for the monthly meter/service fee.

BELW Will Provide:

- All "on-peak" electric energy consumed by the electric vehicle charging equipment will be at the rate of \$.10 kWh, subject to change as rates update.
- All "off-peak" electric energy consumed by the electric vehicle charging equipment will be at the rate of \$.04 kWh, subject to change as rates update.
- The rate is subject to application of any Power Cost Adjustments (PCA)
- The equipment will be available for charging at applicable rates 24 hours per day and is not subject to any load control strategies.
- A separate meter for the customers isolated charging socket.
- Final inspection prior to meter activation to ensure only qualified loads are being supplied through the electric vehicle charging equipment.

Electric Vehicle Charging Equipment Rebate Program

Eligibility Requirements and other restrictions apply. Proof of eligibility is required. This electric vehicle charging equipment rebate is available to Blue Earth Light and Water (BELW) electric utility customers. Equipment must be installed in the service territory of Blue Earth Light and Water. This incentive can be combined with any other available state, federal and manufacturers rebates and incentives. Amount of rebate cannot exceed cost of charging equipment and/or installation costs. Customer must be in good standing with account; we reserve the right to refuse rebate if account is overdue. BELW reserves the right to provide the rebate in the form of a credit adjustment on customer's electric account. Valid for purchase made through December 31, 2022, however BELW reserves the right to cancel this rebate program at any time.

Payment: Please allow 30 days for payment; payment process may take longer if application is incomplete or required information is not included.

Approval and Verification: Pre-approval from BELW is required. BELW reserves the right to verify sales transactions and have reasonable access to your home or facility to inspect the equipment installed under this program, prior to issuing rebates or at a later time.

Warranties: BELW does not warrant the performance of the equipment installed, expressly or implicitly. BELW makes no warranties or representation of any kind, whether statutory, expressed or implied, including, without limitations, warranties of merchantability or fitness for particular purpose regarding equipment or services provided by manufacturer or vendor. Contact your contractor for details regarding equipment performance and warranties.

Application Offer: Details of this program, including rebate levels, are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. Completed and signed applications must be submitted within 60 days of the equipment installation to be eligible.

Application Form: This application must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. The customer must sign, date, and submit the application along with the proof of purchase and registration. Customer agrees that all information is true and that he/she conformed to the eligibility requirements listed.

Endorsement: Blue Earth Light and Water does not endorse any particular manufacturer, product or system design in promoting this initiative.

Tax Liability: Blue Earth Light and Water will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the customer as a result of the payment of rebates.

Limitations of Liability: The liability of Blue Earth Light and Water is limited to paying the rebate specified. Blue Earth Light and Water is not liable for any consequential or incidental damages in tort connected with or resulting from participation in this initiative.

Owner's Certification: Owner/Contractor certifies that he/she has purchased and installed the equipment listed on this form at the defined location. Owner agrees that all information is true and that he/she conformed to all initiative and eligibility requirements listed. Owner has verified that the unit(s) listed have been installed correctly and any necessary permits were obtained. Owner or owner's representation has been instructed on how to operate and maintain this equipment and has received all the necessary operation and maintenance manuals.
